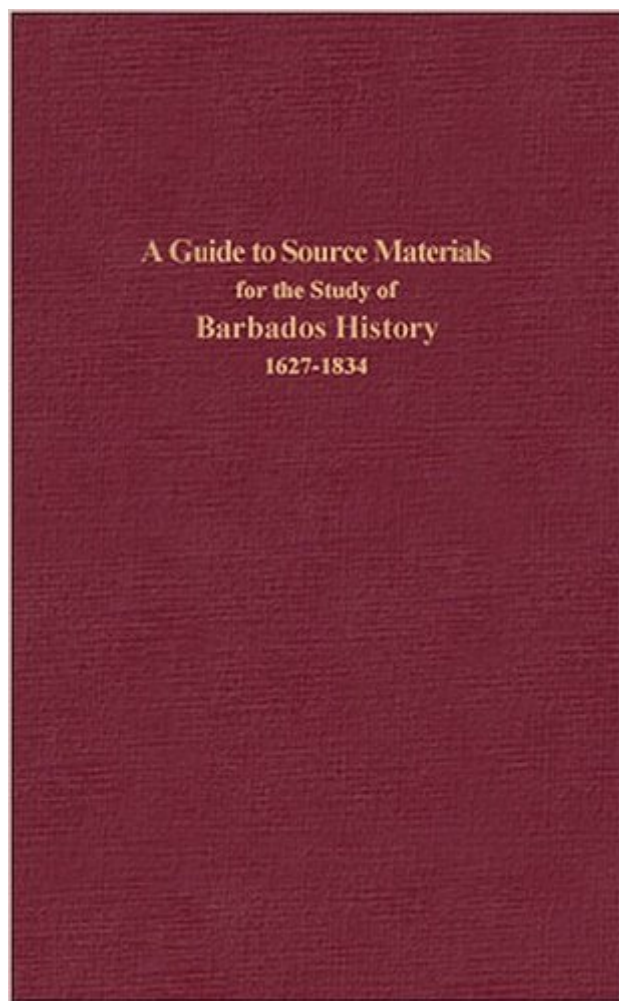


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# A Guide To Source Materials For The Study Of Barbados History, 1627-1834
