

This collection of moments from Christmastime broadcasts of "A Prairie Home Companion" is a very good one. It features excellent music, much of it by the "Hopeful Gospel Quartet". It also has wonderful skits, including Tom Keith's amazingly funny sound effects version of the twelve days of Christmas, and a re-telling of the Christmas story by Garrison and the other actors. The only complaint that I would have about this CD set is that Garrison's brilliant storytelling is not the feature of this compilation. Nevertheless, this compilation is without question worth getting for all of those who enjoy "A Prairie Home Companion".

I originally bought this CD as a gift but was curious enough that I opened it and played it. I love it.

Obviously, I'm keeping that copy and buying another! I am from the Midwest and haven't been back for Christmas in years. Garrison Keillor's wit and homespun stories, the music and the humor all make me anxious to get back there this year. A Prairie Home Christmas is just the kind of down-to-earth Christmas we all need....

I purchased it on a whim as I enjoy Garrison's humor so much, and I am so glad I did! The whole album is a joyful romp celebrating Christmas both as a religious holiday and as a fun, Santa-rich experience. My favorite skit is when Santa starts telling weary shopper Dwayne he needs to 'stop sniveling and get shopping'. Suggesting gift items that include dried food, underwear and stamps. The accompanying song sticks with me throughout the season and gives me a giggle when I need it most. Not exactly a traditional Christmas music album, Prairie Home Christmas offers a lot of sweet, nostalgic, country Christmas charm in a radio show format, that's not to be missed.

This is mostly an excellent series of stories. The only drawbacks are an intermidible song and a long Polish carol with no explanation. I sincerely wish it was re-recorded on CD. It's well worth it for the stories, drama (especially Mary & Joseph trying to get a room at the inn and Christmas shopping), and a couple of the songs.

A Prairie Home Christmas: with Garrison Keillor is a unique collection of songs and skits showing ordinary, and a few not quite so ordinary, people celebrating Christmas. Mr. Keillor did a great job in showcasing the great, the good, and the difficult times and situations that can come up in any given year during the holidays. This is done in the same fashion as his Lake Wobegon Days radio show, where he often will include, as he does here, old hymns and songs of a bygone time. If you have enjoyed any of Garrison Keillor's radio shows, or if you just want a good laugh during the holidays, I highly recommend this recording. It's certainly become a tradition now in mine!

I have owned the cassette version of this for so many years that it was time to update to the CD set! This is, hands down, my favorite Garrison Keillor CD. It shipped promptly and I had time to listen to it before Christmas!

A great choice for fans of all things Garrison Keillor, and great to listen to while wrapping Christmas presents. I would highly recommend it.

Garrison Keillor is very consistent. He is consistently above average while never being exceptional. Just like Powdermilk Biscuits. Ha ha.
